Focal points

- Adult education plays an important role in encouraging lifelong learning in Flanders
- Strengthening labor market opportunities through upskilling and reskilling
- Strengthening digital competences
- Focusing on qualification: fighting early school leaving



Adult education plays an important role in encouraging lifelong learning in Flanders

- A Flanders-wide promotion campaign for adult education
 - Aimed at potential learners and partners
- Education compass (opleidingskompas) presenting the up-to-date adult education offer
- An effective local provision of information with attention for disadvantaged groups and in collaboration with local partners and existing initiatives



Strengthening labor market opportunities through upskilling and reskilling

- actively responding to labor market education needs
 - Region scan
- Futureproof education offer and relating infrastructure
 - Vocational training
- Strengthening prior learning recognitions (EVC) & common framework for exemptions & enhanced coöperation with the examination committee
- Making the education offer more flexible
 - Hybrid learning
 - Integrated trajectories for learners of dutch as a second language and for illiterates and low-literated people



Strengthening digital competences

- A tailor-made education offer of digital skills for all employees
 - ICT-Professionalization for teaching staff
 - Vulnerable groups
- Introducing a digital culture by means of highly flexible forms of hybrid learning
 - Strengthening/expanding of the open learning centers
 - Developing and disseminating resources for distance learning



Focusing on qualification: fighting early school leaving

- reducing unqualified early school leaving
 - through collaboration and an outreaching approach;
 - a reinforcement of student guidance during the learning process
- close cooperation with the Examination Committee and second chance education within adult education
